It is very important that all children who wish to be involved with WeCaValaires Chorus make a firm commitment to the group. Chorus is a team activity where the success of the group depends on many things. Below is a list of my expectations for all members of WeCaValaires Chorus. Please discuss these expectations with your child. If you both agree with them, sign and return this contract to me as soon as possible.

## Expectations:

- Every chorus member is expected to attend all rehearsals. Rehearsals are held on C and F days for 5th grade and B and F days for 6th grade from 2:40-3:20pm in the HS Auditorium.
- On B day, 6th graders will meet with Mr. Duffer. On C days, 5th graders will meet with Mr. Duffer. Every F day, we will meet together (both grades) to rehearse in the auditorium with Mr. Duffer and Mrs. Kubica.
- Students must be on their best behavior in chorus. With 50+ kids, it is very important to have full cooperation from everyone. Behavior expectations include:
  - o Participating by singing and following directions.
  - o Being on time and seated in appropriate place on the risers, ready to work.
  - o Raising your hand if you have a question (we have limited time to rehearse and cannot stop for disruptions).
  - o Following our beginning warm-up routine by signing in, gathering your music and participating in warm-ups with focus.
  - o Being kind, respectful, and helpful to Mr. Duffer and other chorus members.
- If a member makes a poor choice in rehearsal, the following consequences will take place:
  - o Warning

- Attendance at the concerts is mandatory except for extreme circumstances. Members of any chorus learn to depend on the people around them.
